

Second Workshop on

Evaluation of Passive and Active Labour Market Policies for the Long-Term Unemployed and Social Benefit Recipients

Nuremberg, November 23 – 24, 2007

The workshop discusses recent research that evaluates passive and active labour market policies. Theoretical, empirical, experimental and policy-oriented contributions are welcome. Papers that focus on specific groups like long-term unemployed people or unemployed people who receive means-tested benefits are particularly welcome.

Invited Speaker: Peter Fredriksson (Institute for Labour Market Policy Evaluation (IFAU) and Uppsala University)

Registration: The submission deadline is **June 15, 2007**. An electronic version of the paper has to be submitted to IAB.FB9-Workshop@iab.de. The decision on acceptance will be made no later than **July 12, 2007**.

There is no conference fee for participants who present a paper. For external participants who do not present a paper at the workshop the conference fee is € 100.

Reimbursement of travel cost: There is a small travel grant for Ph.D. students, who present a paper at the workshop and provide a letter of their supervisor that confirms their current Ph.D. student status. The grant covers 50 percent of the travel cost, but the grant is limited to a maximum of € 150.
