Ph.D. students interested in applying must send either a substantial draft (minimum 2.000 words) or a full paper as an attached pdf document to phd-workshop@iab.de. The draft can contain a description of your Ph.D. project or a special issue (or a chapter of your dissertation) you want to discuss at the workshop. The document submitted should additionally include contact information (name, university or institution and email address). The deadline for submitting abstracts is 30 April 2008. Notification of acceptance will be announced by the end of May 2008. There will be no conference fee. A travel grant of up to 200 € can be awarded.
