## Agglomeration, Congestion, and Regional Unemployment Disparities Ulrich Zierahn

Regional labor markets are characterized by huge disparities unemployment rates. Models of the New Economic Geography explain how disparities of regional goods markets endogenously arise but usually assume full employment. This discusses regional unemployment disparities introducing a wage curve based on efficiency wages into the New Economic Geography. The model shows how disparities of regional goods and labor markets endogenously arise through the interplay of increasing returns to scale, transport costs, congestion costs, and migration. result. ln agglomeration pattern might be catastrophic or depending on congestion costs. The transition between both patterns is smooth
