

Annual report on enterprises in manufacturing, mining and quarrying

Aim of the statistics: Results of the annual report on multi-unit enterprises are complemented by the annual results for single-unit enterprises of the monthly report on local units in order to generate an overall result for all enterprises of this field of survey. First of all results of the annual report provide data for regional and sectoral structural policy. Those data are indispensable for numerous decisions of legislative bodies, federal and Land governments, associations, chambers and other institutions of economic policy. Data on employees in the annual report on multi-unit enterprises provide essential information for the annual updating of the group of respondents in the entire system of statistics in mining and manufacturing.

Periodicity: Annual

Regional field of survey: Federal territory

Reporting period: Calendar year

Survey population: All enterprises in manufacturing, mining and quarrying with generally 20 or more employees and with 2 or more local units are covered.

Economic branches covered: 10-37

Sampling method: Complete count of enterprises. In 2005, for example, 6,500 companies were questioned.

Survey characteristics: Active persons; remuneration paid; turnover
