

Monthly report incl. survey of new orders for local units in manufacturing, mining and quarrying

Aim of the statistics: The results of the monthly report are used for short-term economic monitoring as well as to provide data for regional and sectoral structural policy. Data of this report are essential for numerous decisions of legislative bodies, federal and Land governments, associations, chambers and other institutions of economic policy. Data on employees at the end of September provide indispensable information for the annual updating of the group of respondents in the entire system of statistics in mining and manufacturing.

Periodicity: Monthly

Regional field of survey: Federal territory

Reporting period: Month

Survey population: The coverage of the monthly report on local units is defined on the basis of the NACE Rev. ¹, which is standardised within the EU - in Germany: German Classification of Economic Activities edition 2003 (WZ 2003) - sections C and D. It comprises all domestic local units of manufacturing, mining and quarrying of enterprises in industry with generally 20 or more employees as well as local units of manufacturing, mining and quarrying with generally 20 or more employees of enterprises outside industry, including producing crafts. For 14 especially small structured branches a different cut-off threshold of generally 10 or more employees is used. Units are allocated to the economic activities according to their main economic activity. Foreign establishments of the company are excluded.

Sampling method: Complete count with cut-off threshold

Survey characteristics: Active persons; turnover; new orders; hours worked; remuneration paid

National legal basis: Art. 2 of the law on statistics in industry (ProdGewStatG) in the version as published on 21 March 2002, amended by Art. 14 of the law of 7 September 2007, Law on Statistics for Federal Purposes (Federal Statistics Law – BstatG) of 22 January 1987, last amended by Art. 3 of the law of 7 September 2007.
