There is no conference fee for participants who present a paper. For external participants who do not present a paper at the workshop the conference fee is € 80.

Reimbursement of travel cost for presenters:

The IAB provides a small travel grant for Ph.D. students, who present a paper at the workshop and provide a letter of their supervisor that confirms their current Ph.D. student status. The grant will cover 50 percent of travel costs, but the grant is limited to a maximum of € 300. The University of Mannheim will cover the cost of one night of accommodation in Nuremberg.
