Topics

The conference aims to bring together high-quality research that is at the intersection of labor economics and macroeconomics. We invite researchers to submit related empirical and theoretical contributions. Papers using microeconomic data are especially welcome. Among the areas of interest are:

- Institutions, wages and labor market dynamics
- Effects of labor market reforms
- Firm dynamics and labor market flows.

Approximately 10 papers will be selected for presentation and discussants will be assigned.
